# Cherokee Ridge Comprehensive Plan PUBLIC INPUT FINDINGS

### Overview

The public input process for Cherokee Ridge's new comprehensive plan has involved a variety of engagement methods and provided valuable insights into the community's vision for the future of the town. Methods of outreach have included target meetings with the project leadership team, a public meeting for residents of the town, and an online community survey. The feedback received throughout the public outreach process has been used to define the community's vision, which determines the general direction and goals of the plan.




### Cherokee Ridge should support continued residential growth/ development.




# What kind of residential development, if any, do you support? (select all that apply)





Cherokee Ridge should support commercial/ retail development.



#### What kinds of businesses would you like to see in Cherokee Ridge, if any? (select up to 4)


