

MINUTES– CHEROKEE RIDGE – REGULAR MEETING – JULY 8, 2024

The Town Council of the Town of Cherokee Ridge met in regular session on July 8, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. in the Cherokee Ridge Club House, 4000 Cherokee Ridge Drive, Cherokee Ridge, Alabama.
