

MINUTES– CHEROKEE RIDGE – REGULAR MEETING – APRIL 10, 2023

The Town Council of the Town of Cherokee Ridge met in regular session on April 10, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Cherokee Ridge Club House, 4000 Cherokee Ridge Drive, Cherokee Ridge, Alabama.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Natalie Burke.

Upon roll call, the following were present: Mayor Natalie Burke; Councilmembers Stephen Britt, Preston Jacobs, Wayne Martin, and Scott Nixon. Absent: Councilmember Russell Bobo. Also present were Town Attorney Alex Smith, and Town Clerk Gail Busbey.

The invocation was given by Gail Busbey. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilmember Jacobs.

The minutes of the work session and regular meeting of March 20, 2023 submitted in writing.

(MINUTES OF MARCH 20, 2023)

MOTION by Councilmember Britt and seconded by Councilmember Nixon that the minutes of the work session and regular meeting of March 20, 2023, be approved as written. Upon roll call, the following members voted Aye: Mayor Burke and Councilmembers Britt, Jacobs, Martin, and Nixon. Nays: None. Mayor Burke declared the minutes of the March 20, 2023 work session and regular meeting approved as written.

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

Mayor Burke reported that Marshall County E-911 had contacted her about changing addresses within the corporate limits to the name of Cherokee Ridge, and that she had furnished them the necessary documentation to do so. She reported that the alcohol license application for the Chevron is being completed.

Mayor Burke presented a list of outstanding bills of the Town and called for a motion to approve payment of the bills.

MOTION by Councilmember Jacobs and seconded by Councilmember Britt that Resolution No. 2023-004 be adopted as introduced. Upon roll call, the following members voted Aye: Mayor Burke, Councilmembers Britt, Jacobs, Martin, and Nixon.

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Nays: None. Mayor Burke declared that Resolution No. 2023-004 had achieved passage.

This being the time scheduled for public comment, Mayor Burke invited anyone present who wished to address the Council to come forward. Jimmy Evans told the council that the website does not accurately reflect future council meeting dates; he also reported that POA sewer tap fees were up to date, with one exception. Mayor Burke thanked him, and said that she would have the website updated.

There being no further business to come before the Council, MOTION by Councilmember Nixon and seconded by Councilmember Jacobs that the meeting be adjourned. Upon roll call, the following members voted Aye: Mayor Burke; Councilmembers Britt, Jacobs, Martin, and Nixon. Nays: None. Mayor Burke declared the meeting duly adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
