

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-0027**

*TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE BACK-TO-SCHOOL SALES TAX HOLIDAY EACH YEAR*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHEROKEE RIDGE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In conformity with the provisions in 40-23-210 through 40-23-213, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the Town of Cherokee Ridge, Alabama, exempts “covered items” from municipal sales and use tax during the third full weekend of July, 2024, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, July 19, 2024 and ending at twelve midnight Sunday, July 21 2024, and continuing each subsequent year thereafter during the same time period as the State’s “Back-to-School Sales Tax Holiday” until and unless annual participation in the exemption is rescinded by further action of the council..

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by 40-23-210 through 40-23-213, Code of Alabama 1975.

Section 3. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon publication.
